The award is presented during the Northeast Regional Conference for the Social Studies sponsored by the Massachusetts Council for the Social Studies.

Nominations for the award should come from a supervisor, principal, fellow teacher or other individual who can provide credible evidence of the nominee's achievements. No self-nominations will be accepted.

The nomination process would require the following:

- submit a letter, which explains why they have nominated this individual. It should include comments on the impact this individual has had on his/her students, colleagues and/or the community. It should include their school and grade taught and the nominators school/position.
