The focus of this session will be on thinking geographically and on how geography can be implemented in classrooms today. The keynote speaker for the March session will be Professor Seth Dixon, a professor at Rhode Island College and Coordinator of the Rhode Island Geographic Alliance. The April session will feature Dr. Rob Hellstrom of the Geography Department at Bridgewater State University. Other presentations will be by experienced classroom teachers presenting tried and tested classroom activities.

Speakers will also include area teachers who will share resources, pedagogy, websites and instructional strategies to engage your students. Materials will be available for different grade levels and could be used as part of an integrated curriculum.

After attending both sessions and creating and posting a lesson plan, participants will receive 10 PDPs. More information will be distributed at the first session.
